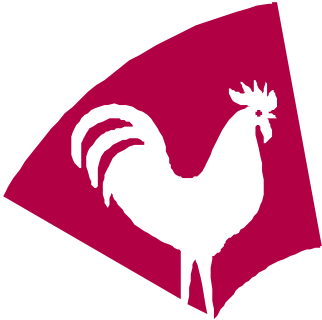

From the Spiritual Director-

On another Walk, at another place, I met a young man—I'll call him John. On Friday night of the Walk, John sat down and talked to me. I could tell he was very distressed. I learned that John was supposed to be married that next day—Saturday. The weekend he was on his Walk to Emmaus, he was suppose to be getting married! But several months before his fiancé had called off the wedding, broken their engagement and his heart. I was quiet for a time and then said, "You still love her don't you?" He said that he did. I then asked if he had any contact with her. He said that she would call occasionally, but would offer no explanation as to why she was breaking off their relationship, and it was all so very hurtful to him. He was in a church for the Walk to Emmaus, but he was suppose to be in a church for his wedding day. One can only imagine the emotions that were working in his mind and heart.

I tried to say to him it might be God's will that he not marry this young lady, or maybe the time wasn't right for them. He wasn't sure, but that seemed to help. He told me he wanted to fast (not eat) the next day – Saturday. I told him that would be okay, but we would be celebrating Holy Communion, and I hoped he would join us. He assured me he would. We prayed.

Saturday came, and John told his Table Leader he needed to know when it was exactly Noon. He said his wedding had been scheduled for Noon and since he didn't has a watch, he needed to know when the time was—he just had to know. Communion came and went for John that Saturday, and he didn't say anything more. But John seemed happier. He was responding to the weekend, he was responding to Christ. His Table Leader later told me when John went to the alter, at the precise moment John dipped his bread into the cup to receive Holy Communion, he looked at his watch, and it was high Noon. When I heard that, I got tears in my eyes, because I knew that in that moment John was not left alone at the alter, but Jesus Christ had been there to supply all of his needs.

The Walk to Emmaus is all about Jesus Christ meeting people's needs. His timing is always perfect. What He supplies is always perfect. This is why we exist as an Emmaus Community. Do you know someone who needs Jesus? Someone who is without love, without hope, who seems so very alone? You must reach out and invite them to a Walk to Emmaus. Jesus will meet them here. In His perfect timing, He will perfectly supply all their needs. They will never be the same—and neither will you!

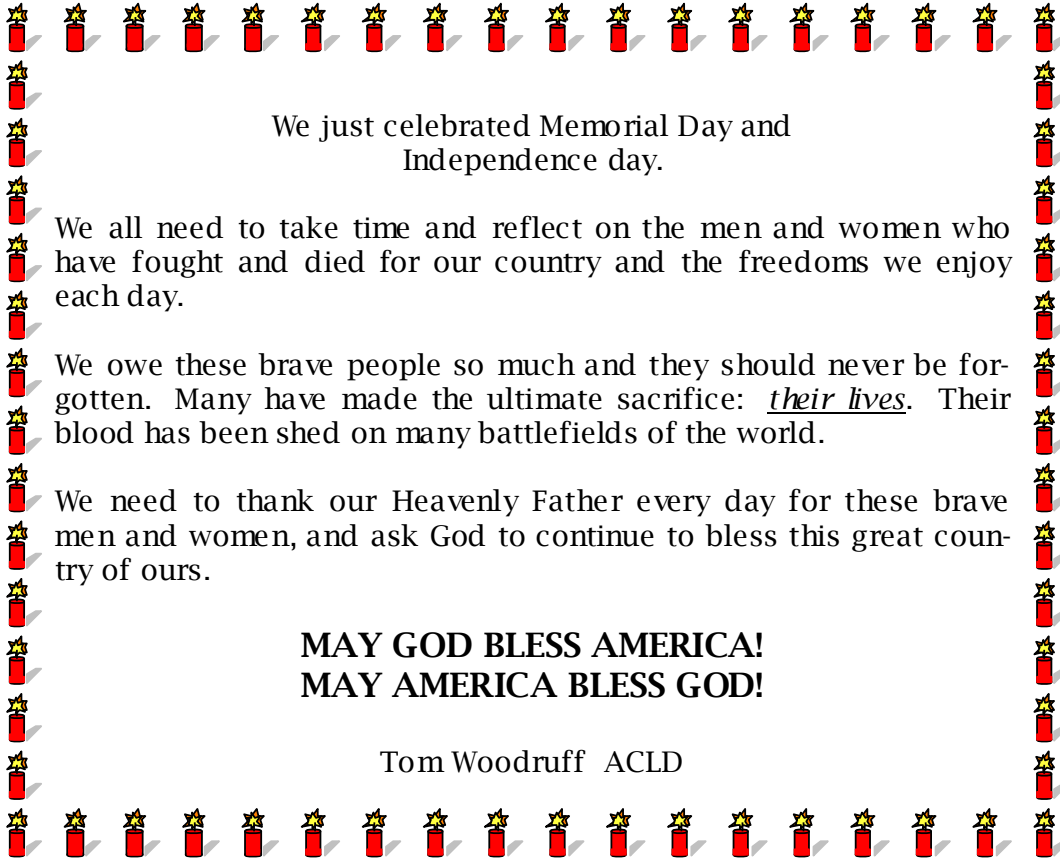
