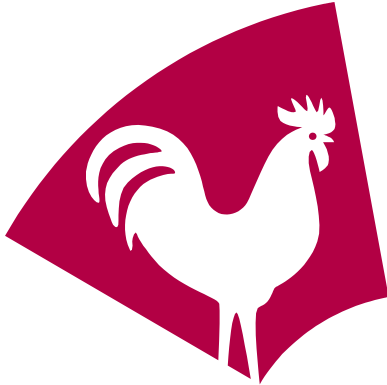

## The Road to Easter

In Luke 24, the Disciples are on the road. It's Easter afternoon, but they don't know it's Easter. They don't know that Jesus is risen, they don't know the whole world has changed. They are depressed and discouraged, their heads are down, their feet drag. But then Jesus appears to them. A stranger at first, but as they got to know Him, they recognize who He is. He understands the past, He knows the present, and He has a plan for the future. Their eyes are opened, and their hearts burn with love. They race back the road to tell everyone that Jesus is alive, that it's Easter!

We were like those 1st Century Disciples. There was a time when we were on the road, but we didn't know it was the **Road to Easter**. We were depressed and discouraged, our heads were down and our feet dragged. Then we saw Jesus. Our eyes were opened! He knew our *past*—and forgave it. He was *present*—reachable, touchable, real. He was *future*—He had a plan to make tomorrow different. He told us why and what we needed to do. In a great way our **Road to Emmaus** has been our **Road to Easter**. But what do we do about it?

- SEE those who are on your road who don't know the truth about Easter.  
*Those discouraged and depressed are probably those Jesus wants you to reach.*
- Let them SEE the risen Christ has changed your life.  
*Let them see your faith in action: Worship, pray study, give, serve, share your story.*
- SHOW them the best is out ahead. Jesus is risen. Easter is coming. It's for them!  
*Walk swiftly, expectantly, and purposely; head up, joy in your heart, praise on your lips.*
- DEVELOP a relationship of deep friendship.  
*Invite them to dinner. Jesus still loves to show up in the breaking of the bread.*
- INVITE them to a Gathering, then to a Walk to Emmaus.  
*Here, it's always Easter! The risen Christ is easily seen—and felt.*

We are on the **Road to Easter** together. We are His disciples. Because of us, may many come to know that Jesus is risen, that the world has been changed, that there are great things ahead, and that He is always with us.
