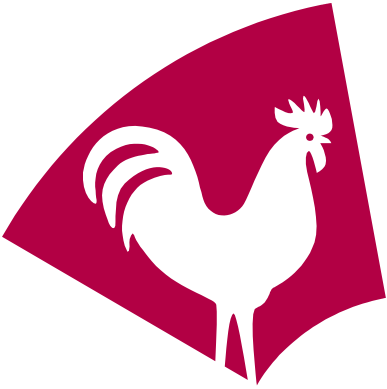


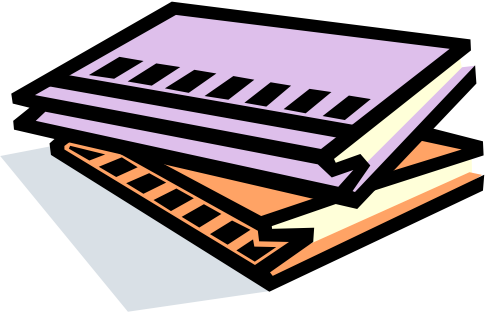

Servanthood—The Example of Andrew

The Bible doesn't tell us a lot about Andrew. He was a disciple, but you can count on your fingers the number of times he's mentioned. However, what it does share reveals that he had the right "heart" for effective service. Andrew's ministry was characterized by significant insights the others didn't seem to grasp.

Andrew understood the *value of people*. He brought individuals to Jesus, no crowds. He served the sick, children, Greeks—even his own brother. When Jesus fed the five thousand it was Andrew who found the boy with the five loaves and two fish. He always found people.

Andrew also understood the *value of invisible service*. Andrew could have had more visibility. He was a leader and among the first to be chosen by Jesus. But he was content to stay in the background. I find that people who choose to serve in the background seldom have impure motives. They do what they do for one reason—they love God.

Lastly, Andrew understood the *value of insignificant gifts*. Andrew knew that no gift is insignificant in the hands of Jesus. When five thousand people were hungry he presented to Jesus a boy with five loaves of bread and two fish. Happy is he who realizes that the reason God chose to partner with me is not because I'm so valuable to Him, but because He is so valuable to me!

Ministry is giving when you feel like keeping, praying for others when you need to be prayed for, feeding others when your soul is hungry, living truth before people even when you can't see results, hurting with other people even when your own hurt can't be spoken, keeping your word even when it is no convenient, being faithful when your flesh wants to run away.

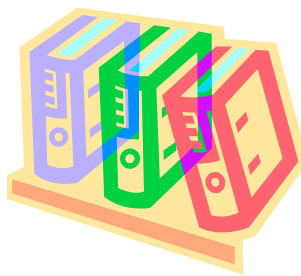
These words describe the countless faithful servants that make the Central Ohio Emmaus Community a life changing experience. Thank you. Serving alongside such self-sacrificing servants of God has been a humbling and challenging experience for me in the time I have served as your spiritual director. Let's pray for one another as we continue to give ourselves away for the cause of Christ through our Emmaus Community. Let me borrow some words from the Apostle Paul in closing. *And let us not lose heart in doing what is good, for at the proper season we shall reap if we do not relax our efforts* (Galatians 6:9). 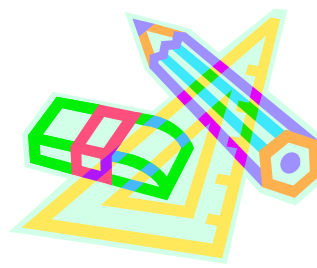
