What Do You Have To Share?

The last recorded words of Jesus are what we generally call the Great Commission. Jesus says in Matt. 28:19-20 “**Go** therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **teaching** them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age.” Jesus first says go, not sit and wait on someone to come by where you are sitting, He doesn’t say to wait for someone to approach you, He says to GO! He then instructs His disciples to teach others. Teachers share information, they share what they know, they share from previous learning and experience. What do you have to share with others?

You and I are the modern day disciples of Jesus, we are to hear and carry out the same message He told the disciples who stood before Him on that day. What do we have to share? Certainly we have the story of Jesus to share, and what He has done to change our lives, and how He makes our lives different. We can invite those who we know and work with to attend church with us. We can invite those who we worship with and work with to attend an EMMAUS WALK. We can invite those who we think might be interested in Emmaus to attend a monthly gathering with us. We can also invite those who are part of our Emmaus community, who haven’t attended a gathering for a while to join us next month. While these previous suggestions which I have shared are worth mentioning, the most important thing which you can share with someone else is to share God’s love with them. Do something nice for someone around you, do something nice just because you want them to know that God loves them.

You and I are commanded by Jesus to **Go** and to **Share** with others. Let us be intentional about this, make it a PRIORITY. The list of items which you can share is much longer than the few suggestions I have made. You and I have this program called Emmaus in common; it has meant a great deal too so many of us, so **share** it with others who we care about.

- ✠ Let us **Go** and invite them to Emmaus, get them to fill out an application.
- ✠ **Go** and call someone from your walk and ask them to meet you at the next monthly gathering.
- ✠ **Go** and invite someone to church with you this week!

Go and **Share** because you are commanded to!
