What is the Central Ohio Emmaus Community Board?

Greetings, fellow community members. As many of you know, our community spans over a period of 20 years and has seen over 3000 pilgrims attend walks during that time. Praise the Lord for His patience, His prevenient Grace, and His calling of those of us who decided to give "our" weekend up for God. To plan and execute a weekend takes much preparation, a boatload of prayer, and the hand of God as was evident with our weekend. As with the preparation of a weekend, so too does the Community need preparation / direction / discernment / etc. This all begins with a Board meeting that is held from 6 to 7 PM just before the Gatherings (2nd Tuesday of every month). The Central Ohio Emmaus Community Board consists of many positions to function as the body of Christ. We are governed by a set operating standards as prescribed by the Upper Room out of Nashville TN. We report on old and new business issues as well as the financial status (non-profit) of our community. It is my privilege to let you know a little bit about the position of Worship Chair. This position, once nominated, and voted on by the Community in a Gathering, is a 2 year commitment. The primary responsibilities included: attend the 12 Board meetings each year (1 per month); arrange 4th Day speakers and special music for the Emmaus Gatherings (note: Each year we have 8 Emmaus Gatherings, 2 Chrysalis Gatherings, 1 Kairos Gathering, and 1 Ephiphany Gathering); help facilitate a harmonious flow for the Gatherings while maintaining an atmosphere of reunion, singing/praising and worshiping (includes song books, prayer cards, hanging the banners @ closing, etc.); provide Communion elements for Gatherings, Candlelights, and Closings services; ensure the proper lighting is in effect, doors are unlocked, and the sound system is in operation for Gatherings, Candlelights, and Closings as well as picking up the sanctuary afterwards. Personally when I was approached about this responsibility, I was in a state of flux. I had recently completed my pilgrim walk and wanted to be more involved with my home church and the ministry of Emmaus, but I was reluctant to sacrifice "my" time away from my family. As you will recall from the Priority Talk, if God truly is first in my life, then I needed to put forth some effort towards fulfilling this priority. Yes, at times this commitment has been challenging, yet with the help of my supporting wife and divine intervention of the Lord, this position has been very rewarding and has blessed me immensely. The revival feeling I have received at the Gatherings through the music and/or the 4th Day talks, as well as the many faces at Candlelight and the testimonies at Closings, all have had a profound impact on me. While I'm in a servant's role, I am getting blessed at the same time. What a deal!!! As I close let me remind you that the survival of our Community requires no doubt the continued blessings from our Lord, but it also requires action and commitment from you, our Community. Please take a moment and reflect how your life has been blessed (not just by Emmaus, but overall) by our Lord. Now, wouldn't it be great to give a little back? This doesn't mean serving in the kitchen all weekend (but many thanks to those who do!) - but even the smallest supporting role will surely bless you in ways beyond belief.

This may mean attending and supporting at least several Gatherings, Candlelights and Closings each year, 24 hour prayer vigils, and the many, many ways to serve on a weekend like the kitchen, logistics, etc. We all know He works in mysterious ways. How else does the body of Christ work when His hands and feet (that would you me) aren't in action? In the months to follow, if you know of someone who would like to sing at a Gathering or do a 4th Day talk, please contact the new Worship Chair, Tom Kramer through the website of www.centralohioemmaus.org and he can work with you for the time requirements and scheduling. I am eternally grateful for the opportunity to serve in this Community and will be in prayer for you from my new home state of North Dakota (please pray for us this winter!). Embrace your Community and be grateful you have one to support!
