Thanks for the Year Past, Hope for the Future

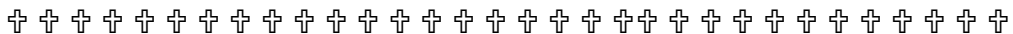
Tom Woodruff – Emmaus Community Lay Director 2004

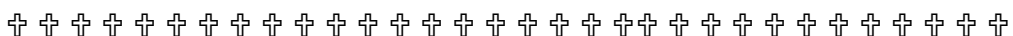

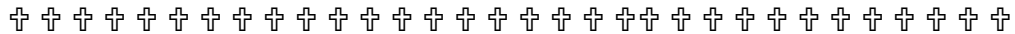


20 Years of Central Ohio Emmaus

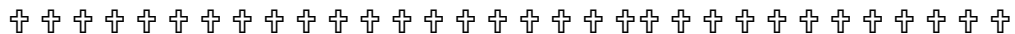
