Have you ever longed to re-experience the love, joy and grace of your Emmaus Walk? Although you can only go on your Walk once, there are many ways to continue the experience. Through serving behind the scenes on a walk, serving on a team, or participating in a share group you can regain many of the same feelings you had on your weekend.

Service is one of those amazing dichotomies of life – at first glance it appears that you are giving of yourself, which you are, but in the end you often get back so much more. There are many ways to serve behind the scenes on a walk. You can serve in the kitchen cooking and serving food at the wonderful meals that are provided for the pilgrims. You can work with the Logistics Chairperson to prepare the church for the pilgrims on Thursday night or clean up on Sunday morning. You can also help with childcare at gatherings, candlelight, or closings so that parents can attend and know that their children are cared for. I am sure you will find that you receive much more than you give. Just knowing that you have helped make possible the same walk experience that you enjoyed is an incredible blessing.

Participating on the team for a Walk helps you understand the incredible amount of work that goes into a walk, while at the same time serving and enjoying seeing the pilgrims bathe in the joy and love of the weekend. Although being on a team is all about service, you cannot help but feel some of the same warmth that you felt on your own weekend. It is amazing to see God working in the pilgrims and to see how their hearts start changing before your very eyes.

Finally, the most consistent way you can continue your walk experience is to be part of a share group. You can be an example to the others in your group, or perhaps learn from others' example.
