## “I Am With You Always”

One of the realizations that I came to on my original “Walk to Emmaus” was that God wanted to be, and was with me all the time. Over the years this knowledge has brought great peace to me at several points in my life. In the good times of life, during joyful times, it is a great feeling to know that God is sharing those with me. During the difficult days in life, it brings peace to me, to know that God is walking through the valley by my side.

In Matthew’s Gospel, Matthew records these final words of Jesus;

**“And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”**

Jesus was talking to His disciples when He spoke these words. It is important to note this, because we are Jesus’ modern day disciples. The eleven disciples that Jesus spoke this original message to have all died. But somehow the word of God has survived all these years and all past generations. It has survived because of people like you and people like me, common people obediently using God’s gifts.

Using the gifts that God has given us, can make us uncomfortable, it causes us to feel stretched and challenged. Paul called them spiritual gifts. I believe that if God blessed us with these gifts, then He intends for us to use them. I would encourage you to ask yourself; How am I using the gifts that God has given me? Am I using them in my church? Have I used them in the Emmaus Community? You and God together can arrive at the answers.

As we take steps into unfamiliar territory, using our gifts, we must remember that God is with us. He will see us through.

During the good days of life, during the difficult days of life and in times when God is using us to continue His ministry, I ask you to always remember Jesus’ final words for you;

**“And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”**
